

York General Hospital has a full-time opening for a Nursing Director of Surgery. This position requires an RN with a current Nebraska license, previous surgery experience and preferably Nursing Leadership. This position oversees all the functions of the surgery department in a 25 bed critical access hospital with over 100 surgeries and procedures per month. This position oversees the surgical team of Registered Nurses, Certified Scrub Techs as well as others involved in the care of the surgical patient.

This nurse leader is responsible for the development and maintenance of nursing surgical standards of care, policies and procedures involving the care of the surgical patient, evaluates and coordinates the selection of equipment/supplies for the surgical department, plans for the orientation of surgical staff, ensures ongoing competency validation, and education activities appropriate to peri-operative nursing.

As the Director of Surgery, this individual communicates and collaborates with physicians, surgery staff, CRNA's, and many other hospital departments. This position requires excellent communication skills, leadership and management abilities, as well as critical thinking and execution of leadership responsibilities. Eligible candidates must have at least 4 years of nursing experience and 2 years of nursing leadership experience.

Must have graduated from an accredited professional nursing program and be licensed as an RN in the State of NE. This position requires current certification in BLS and requires ACLS and PALS within 6 months of hire date.
